ORDER

Some relaxations of the FAWLOI scheme are necessary to address the acute financial crisis and hardship of the workers of the lea gardens of the State, abandoned by their

Considering the grave situation, the Governor is pleased to issue the following guidelines for providing financial assistance to the distressed workers of the abandoned tea gardens of the State in relaxation of the existing norms of FAWLOI contained in Resolution No. 506-IR dated 14.05.98:

- 1. The workers of the Tea Gardens abandoned by the management may be covered under FAWLOI provided such Tea Sardens are not in operation for at least three months due to such abandonment
- 2. The Tea Gardens not in operation due to suspension of work / lock out or strike may not be covered here.
- 3. The benefit may continue up to three months after reopening of the Tea
- 4. A committee consisting of the following members may be formed for assessment and recommendations of the tea Gardens:
 - a) District Magistrate Chairman
 - b) Joint Labour Commissioner, North Zone Member Secretary and Convenor
 - c) Deputy Labour Commissioner, Nember
 - d) Assistant Labour Commissioner of RLO Member
 - e) Block Development Officer Member
- 5. The FAWLOI Screening Committee shall consider such recommendations and
- 6. All other provisions of Labour Department regarding the scheme will remain
- 7. This special provision under FAWLO will be reviewed by the Labour Department after one year from the date of issue of this order.
