

ORDER

In view of gradual expansion of plantations in the State and considering the inadequate number of Inspectors under the Plantation Labour Act 1951 to cope with the administering of the said Act in Plantation areas, the Governor is hereby pleased to order that all Assistant Labour Commissioners posted in North Bengal i.e. in the Districts of Cooch Behar, Jalpaiguri, Darjeeling, Uttar Dinajpur, Dakshin Dinajpur and Malda will also function as Plantation Inspectors in addition to their normal duties for the purpose of smooth implementation of Plantation Labour Act, 1951 provided the administrative jurisdiction of the Inspectors so declared will be decided by the Labour Commissioner, West Bengal.


