

4. Revised rate of adjustment of dearness allowance fixed for the employees employed in TANNERIES AND LEATHER MANUFACTORY in West Bengal

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the power conferred by section 3, read with section 5, of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (11 of 1948), the Governor, after considering all the representations received in respect of the proposal for revision of periodicity of adjustment of dearness allowance published under this department notification No. 38-MW, dated the 23rd April 1993, in the *Calcutta Gazette, Extraordinary*, dated the 23rd April, 1993, and in consultation with the State Minimum Wages Advisory Board, is pleased hereby to revise the periodicity of adjustment of dearness allowance fixed under this department notification No. 5405-LW, dated the 29th December, 1978, for the employees employed in tanneries and leather manufactory in the State of West Bengal in the following manner :

Dearness allowance for the employees employed in *tanneries and leather manufactory* shall be adjusted *half-yearly*, both upward and downward, at the existing rate of neutralisation from the 1st January and the 1st July every year, instead of the 1st September and the 1st March, as at present, on the basis of the average of Consumer Price Index Numbers for the period from April to September and October to March respectively. *The first of such adjustments shall be made from the 1st July, 1993*, on the basis of average of Consumer Price Index Numbers for the period from January, 1993 to March, 1993. The next adjustment shall be made from the 1st January, 1994, on the basis of the average of Consumer Price Index Numbers for the period from April, 1993 to September, 1993. Thereafter, the adjustment of dearness allowance shall be made with effect from the 1st July and the 1st January every year on the basis of the average of Consumer Price Index Numbers for the period from October to March and from April to September respectively. The different Index Series used in the said notification shall remain in force.
