Minimum rates of wages in the employment of **Glass Industry** in West Bengal in terms of Labour Department Notification No. 6407-LW/LW/2W-16/74 Dated 20.7.1974 effective for the period from 01st January 2019 to 30th June 2019.

1. The daily rates of minimum wages of the different categories of employees shall be computed by dividing the total monthly minimum wages by twenty six and shall be rounded off to the nearest paise.
2. To get the weekly rates of minimum wages, daily rates of minimum wages shall be multiplied by six and rounded off to the nearest paise.
