## CIRCULAR

The minimum rates of wages for those in the employment of **GLASS INDUSTRY** in the state of West Bengal covered as per notification number 6407-LW/LW/2W-16/74 dated 20.07.1974 are being hereby fixed as under. These rates will be effective for the period from **1st January**, **2022 to 30th June**, **2022**.

Though there is a decrease in the average consumer price index for Industrial Workers for Kolkata centre for the period from April 2021 to September 2021, there shall be, as per Labour Department Notification No Labr/79/(LC/IR)/ 25034/3/2021 dated 24.01.2022 no increase in Variable Dearness Allowance for the Period from 01.01.2022 to 30.06.2022 for Zone A.

a. Now, with reference to the said notifications, the following shall be the minimum rates of wages in the said employment for the period from 1st January, 2022 to 30th June, 2022.

- 1. The daily rates of minimum wages of the different categories of employees shall be computed by dividing the total monthly minimum wages by twenty six and shall be rounded off to the nearest paise.
- 2. To get the weekly rates of minimum wages, daily rates of minimum wages shall be multiplied by six and rounded off to the nearest paise.
